2025 1st Quarter Update

The first quarter of 2025 has come and gone. Your Board and Staff have been busy with improvements to the club.

Trees were removed on left side of #14 due to roots growing in the bunker and headed toward the green. The first row of trees were removed on right side of cart path on #14 to provide access from the back tees. When the weather warms, we will be sodding the area between #14 green and the cart path. Trees were removed at 16th tee to provide more sun on tee. Shrubs will be planted on right side of tee and sodding will be done at that tee. Trees that were taken out by hurricane on right side of #9 will be replaced with new trees.
